Studies have indicated that it is perceived as less harsh by listeners than white noise and may be better for sleep and stress relief.	
3. The philosopher and author Aśvaghoṣa, believed to be the first Sanskrit dramatist, is known for which epic poem on the life of Buddha? The title of the poem simply means <i>Acts of the Buddha</i> .	
4. The system that functioned as the main administrative structure in imperial China from the Sui dynasty to the Yuan dynasty was known as Three Departments and - how many ministries ?	
5. Which architect's Casa Batllo, a landmark of Barcelona, is known for its facade that resembles human bones?	
6. Which brand of sustainable outdoor wear , founded by Davis Smith, was inspired by his time growing up in South America and is named for a major landmark on that continent?
